Founded in 2025 by Mr. and Mrs. Alexander Ngoasong, this U.S.-based non-governmental organization (NGO) was established with a clear mission: to support vulnerable communities through humanitarian initiatives that improve access to education, clean water, healthcare, sustainable energy, food security, rural development, and emergency relief services.

The organization's work is particularly focused on the conflict-affected regions of Southern Cameroons, with special attention to the Lebialem Division in the Southwest Region of Cameroon. Years of instability and displacement have left many families struggling to meet their basic needs. Recognizing these challenges, the Global Community Outreach Organization has committed itself to restoring hope, dignity, and making a Difference Through Education

Education remains one of the tools for rebuilding communities and creating lasting change. In pursuit of this goal, the Global Community Outreach Organization recently provided 3,000 exercise books and 600 ledgers to 25 schools in the Fontem Subdivision of Lebialem. This intervention has helped thousands of students gain access to essential learning materials, enabling them to continue their education despite difficult circumstances (Inset Photo).nd opportunity to those most affected.



Supporting Critical Infrastructure

In 2026, the organization expanded its impact by undertaking repair works on the major bridge linking Nveh and Menji, the headquarters of Lebialem Division. This bridge serves as a vital transportation link for residents, traders, students, and healthcare providers. By restoring this critical infrastructure, the organization is helping to improve mobility, economic activity, and access to essential services throughout the region (Inset Photo).

Investing in the Future Through Scholarships

Looking ahead, the Global Community Outreach Organization plans to award scholarships to approximately 20 students in Lebialem Division. This initiative is designed to encourage families to resettle in villages and towns that have been abandoned due to the ongoing Southern Cameroons crisis. By supporting students in their educational pursuits, the organization hopes to contribute to community recovery, stability, and long-term development (Inset Photo).
